## A salonworthy pedi — at home

Roxanne Valinoti, celeb manicurist for Creative Nail Design, shares her secrets

**1** Plop a dollop of a soothing exfoliating soak like Freeman Bare Foot Peppermint & Plum Softening Foot Soak (\$4, freemanbeauty.com) into warm water, then immerse feet for 10 minutes.



**2** After soaking, dry feet and clip nails straight across from corner to corner. When done, file the edges, rounding off the corners.

**3** Trace the skin around the nails with a hydrating cuticle-oil pen like Revlon's Expert Effects (\$8, revlon.com), then buff the top of the nail beds until smooth.

**4** Instead of trimming cuticles, push them back using a Mehaz Curette Nail cleaner (\$20, amazon.com). "I run the round, open edge around the nail," Valinoti says about the tool, which resembles a miniature melon baller. "It loosens the dead skin without any cutting."

**5** Moisturize tootsies by massaging them with a lightweight cream that absorbs easily, like Avon Foot Works Watermelon Foot Lotion (\$5, avon.com). Use a cotton ball soaked with polish remover to wipe off any remaining residue on nails.

**6** Finish by applying a base coat, followed by two coats of polish. Let the color dry for 10 minutes and then layer with a high-gloss top coat.
